Slight changes in our meeting format

PFLAG-Olympia meets the second Sunday of every month from 2 to approximately 4 or 4:30 p.m., depending on the program. Most meetings begin with snacks, social time, introductions and announcements followed by a guest speaker, film or other program. This format and length of the meeting may vary depending on the time needed for the program. For example, this year in June we will be tabling at Pride instead of having our usual meeting, and we have a picnic in a park in August.

Two Spirits The film "Two Spirits" will air on PBS' "Independent Lens" June 14th. The film interweaves the tragic story of a mother's loss of her son with a revealing look at a time when the world wasn't simply divided into male and female and many Native American cultures held places of honor for people of integrated genders. It is a beautiful film that poignantly conveys the pain that Paula Mitchell suffered when she lost her child to hate violence in Cortez, CO in 2001.
